Just **\$5** per week (\$260) provides 950 hungry youth with a meal.

Just **\$2** per week (\$104) makes it possible for a child with a physical disability to participate in a 9-week ski program.

Just **\$10** per week (\$520) provides an opportunity for four at-risk youth to attend a week of residential summer camp.

Just **\$4** per week (\$208) provides high quality care for one child for a week.

Just **\$4.88** per week (\$254) provides a child with autism a six-week session of therapeutic horseback riding.

Just **\$2.85** per week (\$148.20) provides a full year of Scouting for a youth.

Just **\$10** per week (\$520) pays for curriculum books & materials for an early literacy program helping children prepare to talk, read & write.

Just **\$4** per week (\$208) sponsors 3 months of self-advocacy training groups for adults with disabilities.

Just **\$2** per week (\$104) provides over 1,000 items of clothing to those who need them.

Just **\$10** per week (\$520) provides one psycho-educational support group for 8 – 10 adolescent boys or girls.

Just **\$6** per week (\$312) keeps the heat on for a family during the winter months.

Just **\$1** per week (\$52) provides comprehensive financial or foreclosure prevention counseling to one household.

Just **\$1.50** per week (\$78) covers the lifetime vaccination cost for the Hepatitis B vaccination for a client.

Just **\$0.85** per week (\$44.20) provides the pneumococcal vaccine for one elderly client providing lifetime protection.

Just **\$20** per week (\$1,040) provides 150 youth with transportation to health care and mental health appointments for 1 year.

Just **\$10** provides one night of shelter for one individual who is homeless.

Just **\$0.33** pays for a tray of food for someone at the Damiano Soup Kitchen.

Just **\$1.00** allows Second Harvest to rescue and distribute \$10.00 worth of food to our Greater Duluth community.
