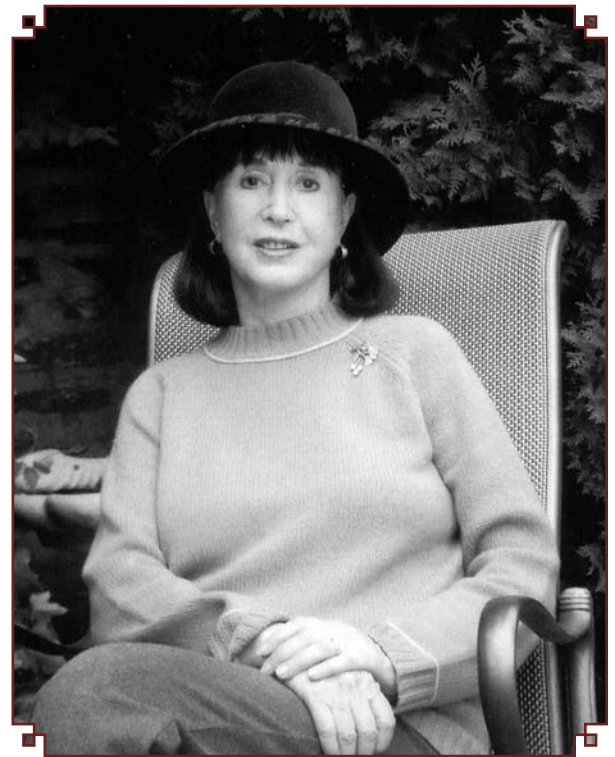
Event highlights include tapas dinner, wine tasting & and silent purse auction.
